

NEW TOOL FOR HOUSEHOLDERS

Busselton Water is launching a dynamic new app for customers interested in tracking and saving water in the home.

The Busselton Water Home Water Calculator guides householders through each area of their home and garden and calculates the household's daily water use.

The tool also compares your water use to the average water use in your area for households of

a similar size – and, most importantly, offers a water use target for those who are up for a challenge!

Busselton Water Managing Director Chris Elliott encouraged all householders to get on board and help meet the region's ambitious water target of 100kL per person per year by 2030. "This handy tool is so simple to use that the whole family can get involved – and it's important to remember that any saving in water, also means a cost saving to the household budget," he said.

The Home Water Calculator will be available via a link on Busselton Water's website this month.


A HELPING HAND
