Comments

Actual results for the period ended 30 September 2021 are positive with revenue exceeding budget projections due to higher than expected developer contributions and connection fees. Busselton Water is maintaining tight control over expenditure in the first quarter of the financial year resulting in the Corporation's net loss being less than budget for the quarter.

The first billing cycle will occur in October which will enable forecast results to be updated more accurately for the second quarterly report.

Revenue and expenditure is aligning to current budget estimates with no adverse trends being identified.

Net Accruals to Government are on target.

Overall, results are positive for the period ending 30 September 2021.
