#### Comments

Actual results for the period ended 31 March 2022 are positive with revenue exceeding budget projections due to higher than expected developer contributions and connection fees. Busselton Water is maintaining tight control over expenditure resulting in the Corporation's net result being higher than budget estimate for the quarter.

The final quarterly loan principal repayment occurred in March 2022 and as a result the Corporation is debt free with the exception of a small number of lease arrangements for IT equipment.

Revenue and expenditure is aligning to current budget estimates with no adverse trends being identified.

The Asset Investment program has been impacted by Covid-19 related market conditions resulting in tenders received being higher than anticipated and delays to material supplies. This effect may result in some project delays and/or deferral of projects.

Net Accruals to Government are exceeding the target estimates.

Overall, results are positive for the period ending 31 March 2022.
